WHAT CAN YOU DO WITH AUTO DETAILING SKILLS?

AUTO DETAILING is a lucrative skill you can add to your automotive career as 12-volt installer, fabricator, upholsterer, vinyl wrapper or as a stand-alone business.

An automotive detailing is much more than a "car wash." Detailing restores or enhances all aspects of the vehicle's appearance: Paint, Chrome, Plastics, Rubber, Carpet, Leather, etc. As a detailer, you will be giving customers the option (and opportunity) to keep their vehicle looking nice for themselves or to boost the vehicle's resale value.
