INLAYS , OVERLAYS, & SEAMS

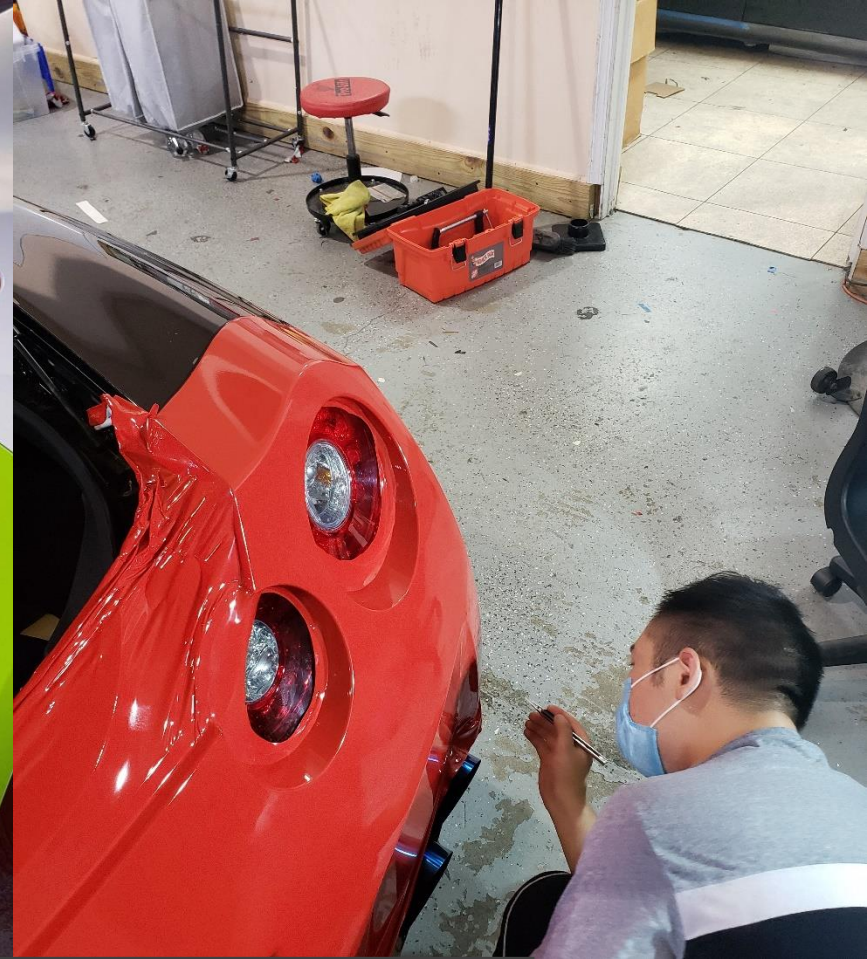
- Inlays and Over Lays are Seams that you are creating on the material
- What is the purpose of an inlay?
 - It is applied to an area where stretching the film in that area is not a good option.
- What is the purpose of an overlay?
 - When you have overlapping areas and when wrapping a car in 2 tone colors or multiple colors
 - When a panel cannot be wrapped with only 1 piece
- When to apply an inlay and overlay?

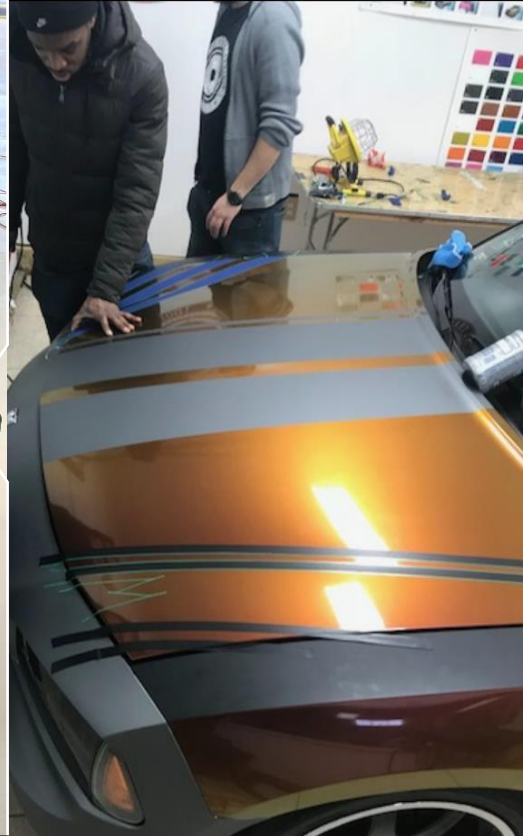

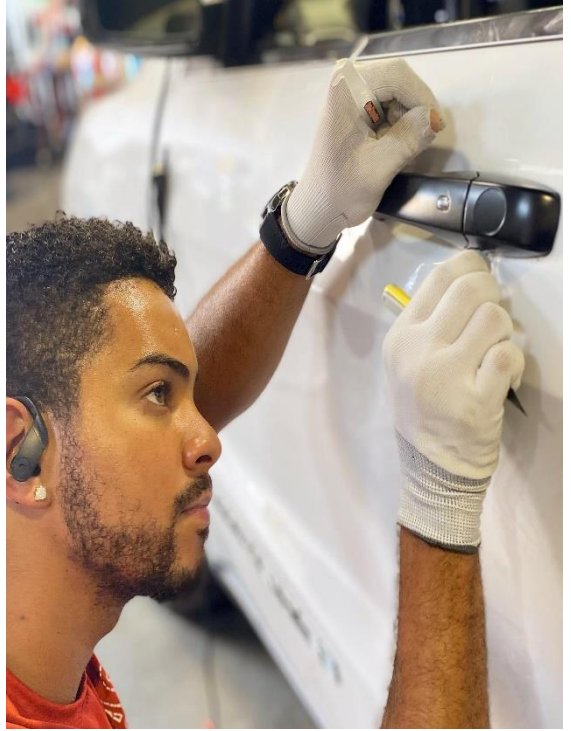
